How to Pray



The Lord's Prayer

One of the disciples asked,
“Lord teach us to pray.”

Pray then like this:

“Our Father in heaven,

It is a Pattern for Prayer

Jesus told His disciples that this is how they should pray, not specifically what words they should pray. It was a pattern of how to talk to God.

The acrostic A-C-T-S is helpful for guiding your prayer time.

A — Adoration. Praise and worship God for who He is.

C — Confession. Confess your sins to God. Specifically what you have done and ask for forgiveness.

T — Thanks. Thank God for the specific blessings in your life, answered prayers.

S — Supply. Ask God to supply your needs. Tell Him where you need His help.

Jesus taught the importance of faithful, persistent prayer. If you trusted Jesus as your Savior, then God is your Father who wants to hear from you, His child. He calls you to bring your worries and needs to Him.

Pray for Our Missionaries

The Apostle Paul said
“Pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the Word, to declare the mystery of Christ.”

Colossians 4:3 (ESV)

Here are some specific things to pray about for our missionaries.
